



## What To Expect On Cruise Boarding Day

- Once you arrive at the **port terminal** you will be able to leave your suitcase (with your luggage tags attached) with the Porter. They will be scanned and loaded on the ship and then placed outside your cabin.
- Once you make your way into the terminal and check in, you will go through **security** much like TSA at the airport.
- Remember, if you are bringing a bottle of **wine or champagne**, you must carry it on the ship with you and not in your checked luggage.
- You will then have a seat to wait for your **group number** to be called and then you will make your way on to the ship!
- Once on board, you can make any **dining or show reservations** you may want. You can also get something to eat in the buffet or one of the dining rooms will be open for lunch service. After that feel free to roam around and check out the ship.
- Your cabin will be ready around 2pm or so but you can go grab your **SeaPass cards** off the door. They will be active so you can stop by the bar for a cocktail!
- You will need to do your **safety briefing** (Muster Drill) and you can do this on your phone or watch it on your cabin TV but this must be completed before the captain can set sail.
- After you watch your safety briefing, you will be instructed to report to your **Muster Station** to check in with the crew members there and then you are free to start enjoying the ship! Please don't be one of those people that ignores the safety briefing and doesn't check in at your station. Yes... they will call you out over the PA System. They will continue this until all guests on board have completed it.





## What To Expect On Cruise Boarding Day

- When they announce that **cabins** are ready, you can make your way to your cabin and start unpacking.
- They will have the **Sail Away party** on the pool deck where you can wave to all the people on stuck on land as you sail away!
- Everyone will have the **early dining time** at 5:30pm so after the Sail Away at 4:00pm, you can return to your cabin and get ready to head to the dining room to enjoy your first dinner at sea!
